

Damage Rebills under \$50 waived

Decrease invoice processing time, keep your drivers on the road and save money, all with an updated trailer turn-in process from Trailer Fleet Services. Any damage repairs costing less than US\$50*, on a trailer returned after a 90-day or greater lease or rental, will not be charged. Automatically! Your drivers get out the door faster and you no longer receive rebills under \$50.

How it works.

The repair itself is not waived but we won't bill you for the damage if the total charge at time of turn-in is less than \$50.

Regardless of the type of repair - whether it is a broken registration holder, a broken light or a loose sheet of plywood, if the damage is under \$50, we won't bill you.

Waived damage repairs will show as "No Charge" items on your next regular monthly invoice.

* Based on the GE Trailer Fleet Services national price list and branch standard labor rates. This waiver does not apply to mobile maintenance services on GE trailers, or to customer-owned trailers, or to damage repaired while the trailer is on lease or rent. The \$50 waiver is included in any contractual deductible clause and is not an addition.
